Urgent reminded...... We still have 4 members and 8 owners that have not paid their dues and rental or dock fees. If these are not paid by 3/7, you will violate the by-laws and will forfeit your dock or rental slip. These were due on January 31st. Please contact me if you have any questions or want to meet up to pay.



We have 26 trailers that have names and numbers on them. Thank you, owners.....But we have 20 trailers with no information on them. I have marked them with orange tape. Please take some time to stop by and update your trailer this week before they are removed from the trailer area.

It has been really nice to see the new dock owners rehabbing their docks and, in some cases, totally starting over. Please remember as the weather starts getting warm again, all owners will need to power wash, paint if needed and replace damaged walkways if needed. We have a lot to be proud of, so let's make sure the docks look great when we have potential members and guests on the grounds.

GROUNDS DIRECTOR: Mike Hamende SMBC Work Day

- 1. Need member with a tiller to till area by tree by B Boat slips for re-seeding and till volleyball court.
- 2. Rake gumballs and put in cans or tarps and put in the dumpster
- 3. Blow leaves away from building and out of playground and bocce ball courts, away from ramp to A boat slips and away from the shoreline. We will then use a zero turn mower with a bagging system to pick up leaves and dispose of in the boat trailer area
- 4. Pick up sticks and limbs on grounds and in boat trailer area and put on a flatbed trailer and put on brush pile on side of the road across from old DAV club
- 5. Need a couple of members with weed eaters to weed eat around the shoreline, playgrounds, and in the boat trailer area
- 6. Need someone to push mow boat trailer area where trailers are parked. Be careful of woodblocks used for trailers. Stack blocks in pile near a tree to prevent mower damage
- 7. Mount hose reels from beach house to A & B boat slips
- 8. Put out 6 garbage cans with bags 1 on the patio, 1 at A slips, 1 at B slips, 2 at the pavilion, 1 at the boat launch. More cans will be added during the summer
- 9. Rake tree stump shavings from behind docks 85 & 87, put shavings in trash cans, and dump in woods in the boat trailer area
- 10. Pull patio furniture and flowerpots out of beach house and place on patio after gutters are cleared and patio is cleaned off.
- 11. Rake gumballs out of volleyball court and install volleyball net
- 12. Members with chainsaw or saws-all to cut small sapling trees/brush in boat trailer area to make room for additional trailers
- 13. Plant 4 new trees
- 14. With a 4-inch brush, stain bocce court rails. This is weather permitting as it may need to be done at a later workday when it's warmer
- 15. Clean up trash behind the beach house. Take all scrap metal fencing and put it up on the sidewalk. Need a member to take scrap metal to salvage yard. There is also scrap metal in the boat trailer area that needs to be taken in



I would also like to have some additional "work" half-days to help maintain the club grounds throughout the year. My number is 971-5464 if you have any questions or ideas




BUILDING DIRECTORS: BIII Atteberry and BRUCE OBERREITER Bill Atteberry and Bruce Oberreiter:
